



## Master of Teaching Programme – Answers to common questions

1. *I am a head teacher and have a group of staff who would like to apply for the MTeach but don't really want to travel to London to attend sessions. Is there any chance that you could teach us on school premises?*

This is possible, as long as you have a viable group. If not, you might want to consider joining forces with other schools in the area.

The MTeach team has a long history of working with school-based cohorts in this way, and welcome such approaches from all secondary and primary schools. As a significant component of the programme consists of online learning, the programme is accessible to many who might otherwise find it difficult to combine Master's study with a demanding career.

2. *Would there be any chance of a reduced fee if this happened?*

Yes, but it would depend on the size of the cohort. The MTeach team are more than happy to discuss special fee rates with schools.

3. *Who would I contact to set this up?*

4. *I have level 7 credits from my PGCE that I want to use towards a Master's degree. Could I still apply for the MTeach?*

Yes, it is possible to transfer up to 60 level 7 credits to the programme, subject to approval of the programme leader. In this case, you would only need to pay for the remaining credits you would take towards your degree.
