This guide provides a summary listing of re-usable and licensed online audiovisual (AV) resources.

Searching for re-usable AV resources

[JISC Digital Media](#) provide a series of guides to finding online audiovisual material. As a starting point, you may want to have a look at the guides [Finding Video, Audio and Images Online](#) and [Finding Subject-Specific Digital Media Resources](#).

The JISC Digital Media website also features guides to individual types of resource linked from the [Advice homepage](#).

When re-using existing resources always bear in mind the copyright implications of using material created by others; again the JISC site provides [advice on copyright](#) which we recommend you note.

Although the JISC site is a few years old now, it also has useful advice on using search engines to locate material, reviewing the merits of various general and specialist sites. The advice covers [still](#) and [moving](#) image, and [audio](#).

The IOE does not have full access to the subscription resources inside the [JISC MediaHub](#) but the site is still provides a useful starting point for locating resources. The section marked with the unlocked padlock symbol:



can be useful for locating collections available outside the MediaHub. These will all have their own terms of use which should be observed.

Searching for 'licensed' resources on the IOE Library web pages
