Programme information

The course will help you to:

- Deepen the understanding of your role in leading learning
- Increase your ability to manage and develop people in your team
- Help you to plan for your own personal leadership development.

Who can apply?

The programme is ideal for anyone who has been leading a team for a minimum of two years for example - heads of subject, year, faculty, house and cross-curricular teams in all phases. It is also suitable if you lead a team of administrators or teaching assistants.

Accredited Programme

Developing Leaders is accredited with the Institute of Education's Graduate Diploma in Professional Studies and can be used to gain 30 CATS points towards an MA.

Fees

Fees are £500 for the six month professional programme which includes three face-to-face leadership days and finishes with a twilight celebration session at the Institute of Education.

Start dates

May 09 (Cohort 1) or October 09 (Cohort 2).

Main aims of leadership days

Day 1: Where are you now?

to understand and consider:

- the differences between leadership and management
- the implications of leadership styles
- how motivation affects leadership
- climate and culture
- making judgements
- the significance of trust
- current roles and values

Day 2: Where would you like to be?

- to practice coaching skills
- help participants think about where they want to be
- understand change management
- develop strategies to overcome barriers to change and challenge behaviours

Day 3: How will you get there?

- to consider aspects of teamwork and motivation
- plan future development
- understand the accreditation routes

Inter-sessional tasks

Inter-sessional tasks will be undertaken between the leadership days including the completion of an online 'Motivational Map' between Day 1 and 2. Participants will have access to a 'Virtual Learning Environment' during the programme.

Twilight session

The programme will finish with a celebration and learning conversation when participants will present their action research.
