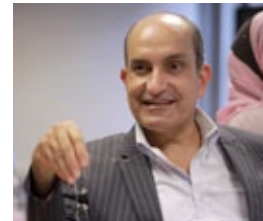


# Widening Leadership

### Day 1: Communication

### Inter-sessional tasks

Inter-sessional tasks will be undertaken between the leadership days including the completion of an online 'Motivational Map' between Day 1 and 2. Leaders will carry out action research which will involve working across the school or with another team. Participants will have access to an online network throughout the programme to enhance learning and enable further networking

### Twilight session

The programme will finish with a learning conversation and celebration when participants will present and discuss their action research.
